





The bright blue cascade of houses in Jodhpur are a striking contrast against the chromatic sands of the Thar Desert. The Blue City is an underrated but often overlooked choice for people travelling to Rajasthan. And this is our attempt at changing that notion a little. If you look at the city through our eyes, it's more than just palaces, desert dunes, and forts.


Daspan House



Daspan House finds itself as part of a residential neighbourhood and welcomes each guest with the fresh smell of mogra, birds chirping and the calming sounds of water.

This 100-year-old intricately carved sandstone structure with double-height ceilings, decorative spiral staircase and cut-glass chandeliers overlooks the symbolic Khajoor tree in the centre of the lush Mughal garden. The monumental structure houses 18 individually styled rooms that have been curated and designed with refurbished furniture, frames and artwork.





Daspan is also home to Old Loco, a casual restaurant and bar that focuses on world cuisine & classic cocktails, serving evergreen classics using local & fresh ingredients.

They firmly believe that the people make a hotel feel like a home and do not compromise on the generous hospitality and warmth.

AN ABODE OF NATURAL FARMING & MINDFUL LIVING



A forty-acre experiential farm in Jodhpur,

Mharo Khet is home to more than 100 varieties of natural and organic crops and provides soothing experiences in the lap of nature.

It is a majority-women led, community-inclusive, responsible farming enterprise that showcases the beauty of farming and sustainable living. Visitors can find almost every exotic crop, from brussel sprouts, moringa, strawberries, and chamomile to oyster mushrooms and figs.



Mharo Khet also organizes immersive walking tours and offer pre-plated, multi-course, plant-forward culinary meals set against the background of a picturesque sunflower-filled farm.

Insia Lacewalla

Insia spent a large part of her childhood travelling India with her parents and grandparents and fell in love with the landscape.



Her journeys traverse a history of forgotten lands, cultures that are fading away, heirloom recipes and stories of people who've not only opened their homes but also their hearts.

These stories inspired her to launch India with Insia,

a curated Indian travel platform for the discerning millennial. India with Insia focuses on content around boutique hotels and curated experiences in India.

Day by Day Itinerary

DAY 1

Arrive in Jodhpur in the afternoon.
Check into Daspan House by or before 4 pm.

High Tea with some local foods overlooking the pool, lush Mughal garden and Jodhpur skyline.

Free time to head into town and explore Jodhpur a little

Dinner that includes a tasting menu with family-style sharing portions and signature cocktails at Old Loco

DAY 2

Leave for Mharo Khet after breakfast.

A light but elaborate 7-course, pre-plated, plant-forward menu that includes reinvented classics from around the world.

Interactive farm tour around the property, meet the inspiring women-led team and have the chance to produce harvest.
Enjoy downtime to catch a nap, enjoy the swings, fly kites and play village games.

Enjoy an early dinner against the setting sun at the fields with a 7-course, pre-plated Western Indian menu followed by Aaj Rang Hai, a Sufi musical performance focusing on local musical instruments of Rajasthan (Morchang, Khartal, Algoza).

DAY 3

Explore Jodhpur on foot with a walking tour around the blue neighbourhoods of the city while you snack on some authentic Rajasthan street food. This one's an early start!

Brunch at Daspan House before the group disperses

Depart to airport around lunchtime.


